**CHAMPIONS AND PREMIERS**

The Title of Champion and/or Premier shall be granted to a cat winning three Challenge Certificates at three shows under three separate judges. A GCCF Challenge Certificate will be offered for each Open/Neuter Class winner of recognised breeds with CH/PR status.

**CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS & PREMIER OF PREMIERS**

The title of Grand Champion shall be granted to a cat winning three Challenge Certificates at three shows under three separate judges. To compete in a Champion of Champions Class a cat must be a full Champion/Premier. A Champion cat may be entered in its ordinary breed Open Class and in the Champion of Champions Class. Only one prize with a Reserve in case of disqualification will be awarded to Male or Female. The title of Grand Premier shall be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as those for GR CH.

### **IMPERIAL GRAND CHAMPIONS – IMPERIAL GRAND PREMIERS**

The title of Imperial Grand Champion will be granted to a cat winning five Grand Champion Certificates at five shows under five different judges. To compete in the Imperial Grand Champions Class, a cat must be a full Grand Champion. A Grand Champion cat may be shown in any TWO of the following: The Open Class; the Grand Champion Class; the Imperial Grand Champion Class. Only one prize with a Reserve in case of disqualification will be awarded. The title of Imperial Grand Premier will be granted to neutered cats under the same rules and conditions as those for Imperial Grand Champion.

### **SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. A copy of the Rules is obtainable from the GCCF Offices, 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgewater, Somerset TA6 4AG. Price £2.00 and must be read by all exhibitors for they are not repeated herein, but will be strictly applied. Ignorance of the Rules will not be an acceptable excuse for their breach.

### **REGISTRATION**

All cats, kittens and neuters except those entered in the Non-Pedigree Section must be registered with the GCCF. To be effective for entry all registrations and/or transfers must reach the GCCF Office at least 21 days before the show. No cats or kittens entire or neutered, born after 19/10/71, with one or both parents unregistered shall be eligible for the Open Classes. If the registration number has not been received when completing the Entry Form write RAF (Registrations applied for) in the appropriate column and forward the number as soon as possible to the Assistant Show Manager.

Your first choice of name should be entered in the appropriate column on the entry form.

### **SHOW ENTRY**

**PEDIGREE SECTION:** The exhibitor must complete the Official Entry Form and subscribe to the declaration therein. Every exhibit must be identified on the entry form exactly as recorded on the registration/transfer certificate relating to it. Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of the exhibits and for entering them in the correct classes. If an exhibit is owned by two persons both must sign the entry form and both must be members of the Clubs guaranteeing the classes entered.

**NON-PEDIGREE SECTION:** All unregistered Cats, Kittens & Neuters of unknown or unregistered non-pedigree parentage are eligible for entry in the Non-Pedigree Section.

All Non-Pedigree cats over 6 months must be neutered.

**ONLY ENTRIES MADE ON THE BLUE PERSIAN CAT SOCIETY ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** No Cat, Kitten or Neuter from the same household may be entered in two shows held within 13 days. Please do not omit to read & sign the Declaration.

### **VETERINARY**

Exhibits will be received at the entrance of the Show Hall from 7.45 am to 9.45 am on the morning of the Show. All exhibits must be brought to the show in baskets or suitable containers and must be accompanied by the owner or owner's representative. Each exhibit will be examined by the Club's Honorary Veterinary Surgeons who are authorised to exclude any exhibit they consider to be unfit, this includes exhibits showing skin lesions. No exhibit may be penned before being so examined. Exhibits must have clean ears and be free from pests. Pregnant and lactating queens may not compete. No exhibit that has been de-clawed will be admitted. Also no letters from owners' vets will be considered. Unfit exhibits must be removed by the owners and Entry Fees forfeited. If in the Veterinary Surgeon's opinion it is desirable, all other exhibits from the same cattery and the owner thereof shall be debarred from attending the Show.

The Veterinary Surgeon's decision is final. When an exhibit has been rejected or withdrawn from the show by a Veterinary Surgeon, it shall not be represented to a second Veterinary Surgeon. The procedure to be adopted in such cases is clearly stated in the GCCF Rules.

### **VETERINARY CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES**

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected please note the following points:-

- 1) When sending your clearance certificate to the Veterinary Office, please include your copy of the rejection slip.
- 2) Please **DO NOT** send these certificates by recorded delivery post as this can cause considerable delays in the receipt of your certificates. If you wish to satisfy yourself that your letter has reached the Veterinary Officer please enclose a stamped addressed postcard acknowledging receipt, for signature, and this will be returned to you.
- 3) Exhibitors should not attend shows until they have received a letter accepting and confirming clearance from the Veterinary Officer. It is recommended that this letter should be taken to shows within one month of issue.

If an exhibit is unable to attend the Show for whatever reason, the Show Manager must be notified in writing. No fees will be returned after the Official closing date for entry to the show as published in the Schedule.

**ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE INNOCULATED AGAINST FELINE INFECTIOUS ENTERITIS and CAT FLU – amended rule (Section 2 Rule 5e, effective 01.06.02) All exhibits must have a current vaccination certificate against FIE,FVR and FCV (cat flu). The full course or booster in accordance with the manufacturers' recommendation must have been completed more than seven days before the show. The certificate must have been issued by a veterinary practice/hospital and the last entry signed by a Veterinary Surgeon or by a listed veterinary Nurse under the direction of a Veterinary Surgeon. Cats without a valid vaccination certificate will be rejected under Section A. The certificate should clearly indicate the identity of the exhibit and owners and must be available for inspection at vetting-in NB; Homeopathic vaccination cannot be accepted for the purpose of showing under Section 4 Rule 4f. Cats with an invalid vaccination certificate will be rejected under Section A**

#### **PRESENTATION OF EXHIBITS**

Exhibitors must provide each exhibit with a white sanitary tray, drinking dish and clean white or near-white blanket without distinctive marking or edging, which may be arranged in such a manner as to assist the comfort of the cat. Cellular blankets are not allowed but white vet-bed or like material with white or green backing may be used if you prefer, none of this equipment must bear any distinguishing marks. Judges are instructed to pass any pen that is distinguished in any manner. Food containers must be removed from the pen when judging commences at 10.00a.m., and must not be returned until 1.00p.m. Vetting-in slips and exhibitors' passes will be handed to exhibitors at vetting-in.

No written or printed matter of any kind other than official notices and awards may be put on competitive pens. Exhibits received into the Show Hall must not be removed without the sanction of the Show Manager. They are received only on condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits, carriers or other property. The Show closes at 5.00p.m., or when announced by the Show Manager and no exhibit may be removed from the hall before this time: it is an offence to leave before the Show has been officially closed.

#### **EXHIBITORS**

Any exhibitor in any way interfering with or removing any exhibit from its pen during the Show, except with the consent of the Show Manager, will forfeit any award which may be due to his or her exhibit. No one may remove any exhibit from its pen except the owner or a Show Official. All exhibitors are forbidden to carry their exhibits around the Hall. Also no one may take photographs of any exhibits at this Show without first getting permission from the Show Manager and then getting permission from the cat's owner. **ANYONE CONTRAVENING THIS ORDER WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE HALL AND THEIR CATS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

#### **JUDGES**

Judges are empowered to withhold any prize or Challenge Certificate if the exhibits do not, in their opinion, possess sufficient merit. Prizes will be awarded from the judges' slips. In the event of an emergency, judges may be changed during the day.

#### **COUNTERSIGNING OF CERTIFICATES**

In the event of a judge change of an Open Class occurring after the closing date for the Show, and provided that the exhibitor informs the Show Manager prior to judging that a certificate has previously been awarded by the replacement judge, the Show Manager shall appoint one other judge who shall judge the cat, and if the cat is considered worthy, countersign the Certificate, which shall then count towards Championship status.

#### **THE COMMITTEE RESERVE TO THEMSELVES THE RIGHT TO:-**

1. Appoint other judges should those advertised not be able to fulfil their engagements and to appoint further judges should they be required.
2. Fix and limit the number of exhibits at the Show and to accept or refuse entry without giving reason.
3. Cancel, amalgamate or divide classes.
4. Publish a catalogue of the Show containing information as to the exhibits and the names and addresses of exhibitors.
5. Hold this data on a computer for the purposes of preparing the show paperwork.
6. Retain a percentage of the Entry Fees to cover essential expenses in the event of the Show being cancelled for any reason.
6. All Exhibitors' property is left in the Show Hall at the owner's risk.

#### ADVICE TO EXHIBITORS AS FROM 1.6.92

- a) You are advised about purchasing any shampoo that changes a cat's coat colour as this can lead to disqualification.
- b) Homeopathic Vaccinations are not acceptable to the GCCF for Vetting-in.
- c) Any alterations to your Show Entry must be in writing which will be attached to the entry form by the Show Manager. You may also make corrections up to the close of the Show.
- d) Kittens under 14 weeks may not now be shown.
- e) Any person whose cats have been rejected under Section C or D must not officiate as a Judge/Steward or in any other capacity which requires the handling of cats at Shows until a Clearance Certificate, as required by the GCCF has been obtained.
- f) The use of small battery driven fans in pens can be dangerous and could also be considered a distinguishing mark.
- g) Please note that in addition to the Classes you have entered your cat may be handled for the purpose of assessing candidates in the GCCF appointment scheme.
- h) Queens who have kitted within 14 weeks of the date of the Show may not be shown.

#### CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence must be accompanied by a stamped addressed envelope if a reply is required. Any complaint relating to the Show must be forwarded in writing to the Show Manager within seven days of the Show. It is recommended that exhibitors enclose a stamped addressed envelope/postcard with their entries to be returned as acknowledgement of receipt of entries.

#### NOTICE OF CHANGE

An announcement in "OUR CATS" of any alterations or additions made to the schedule or in these regulations shall be sufficient notice thereof. Additionally Judge changes will be posted on the BPCS website at [www.bluepersiancatsociety.co.uk](http://www.bluepersiancatsociety.co.uk).

#### RULE ON BITING AT SHOWS (Effective 1.6.88)

Any cat biting or inflicting injury by deliberately scratching a Judge, Veterinary Surgeon, Steward or other Show Official must be reported to the Show Manager. The Show Manager must withdraw the cat from the Show and shall inform the Owner of the cat in writing, sending a copy to the Secretary of the GCCF. If the cat was defending itself in exceptional and frightening circumstances, that information should be given to the Secretary of the GCCF for consideration by the Executive Committee. If the cat is reported at any subsequent Show, it shall be disqualified from all future Shows unless the Executive Committee rule otherwise.

#### JUDGING

Judging will start at 10.00am prompt. The hall will not be cleared, only the aisles, exhibitors will be permitted around the edges and at all stalls. The show will be open to the public at 11.00am.

#### DEFINITION OF CLASSES

<b>OPEN CLASS:</b>	Open to all of the specified breed. (Must be GCCF Registered)
<b>CATS:</b>	9 calendar months old and over on the day of the Show.
<b>KITTENS:</b>	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 months old on the day of the Show. Since 1 June 2001, neuter kittens are entered in kitten Open and Miscellaneous classes and compete for BIS Kitten. Neuter Kittens of Preliminary Breeds should be included in Kitten Assessment classes where separate classes for Adult, Kitten and Neuter are scheduled.
<b>NEUTER ADULTS:</b>	Neuter adults may only enter Neuter Classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include Neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the best Neuter shall be considered against the best Entire Adult and Kitten for Best Exhibit in Show.
<b>LIMIT:</b>	Exhibits that have not won more than four First Prizes in any Class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>SPECIAL LIMIT:</b>	Exhibits that have not won more than two First Prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rule
<b>NOVICE:</b>	Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a Show held under GCCF Rules.
<b>DEBUTANTE:</b>	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules.(If Debutante Adult and Neuter classes are offered at a show, entry as a Debutante Kitten does not count when the exhibit is shown as an adult or neuter and entry as a Debutante Adult or Kitten does not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown.)
<b>MAIDEN:</b>	Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize in any class held under GCCF Rules.
<b>BREEDERS:</b>	Exhibits bred by exhibitor(s).

<b>JUNIOR:</b>	<b>Cats over 9 calendar months under 2 years on day of Show.</b>
<b>SENIOR:</b>	<b>Cats over 2 years and under 5 years old on Show day.</b>
<b>VETERAN:</b>	<b>Cats 5 years old and over on day of Show.</b>
<b>RADIUS:</b>	<b>For cats and kittens living under 25 miles from the show hall.</b>
<b>VISITORS:</b>	<b>For cats and kittens living over 25 miles from the show hall.</b>
<b>ARISTOCRAT:</b>	<b>Exhibits with 1 or 2 Challenge/Premier Certificates, but not CH or PR</b>
<b>BRACE:</b>	<b>2 exhibits from the same household: adults, kittens &amp; or neuters</b>
<b>TEAM:</b>	<b>3 exhibits from the same household; adults, kittens &amp; or Neuters</b>
<b>PURE BRED BLUE:</b>	<b>Exhibits with at least 5 generations of exclusively blue parentage.</b>

The status of the exhibit for entering restricted classes (i.e. Maiden, Limit etc.) shall be the cat's status on the date of entry, except where Section 2, Rule 7e regarding entry into the Grand Classes applies. The wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter; the wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit Awards do not count as 'wins' for entering restricted classes.

- **Travelling North on the M5**

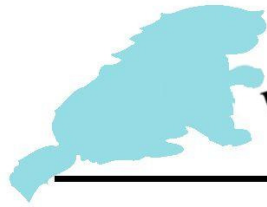
